It takes an average of seven thousand years on the physical plane to complete it. There are thirty-five soul age levels. That's about 200 years per level. However, some levels, such as 3rd and 6th, take more time, and some, such as first and seventh, take less. People generally take 100–200 lifetimes to complete the physical plane, depending on their average lifespan, speed of moving through the levels, and personal preference. The fewest known is 37, and a “specialist in infant mortality” took 1500 lives.
